We landed on Singapore's National Day. The city was especially busy, with large crowds gathering throughout the holiday weekend.

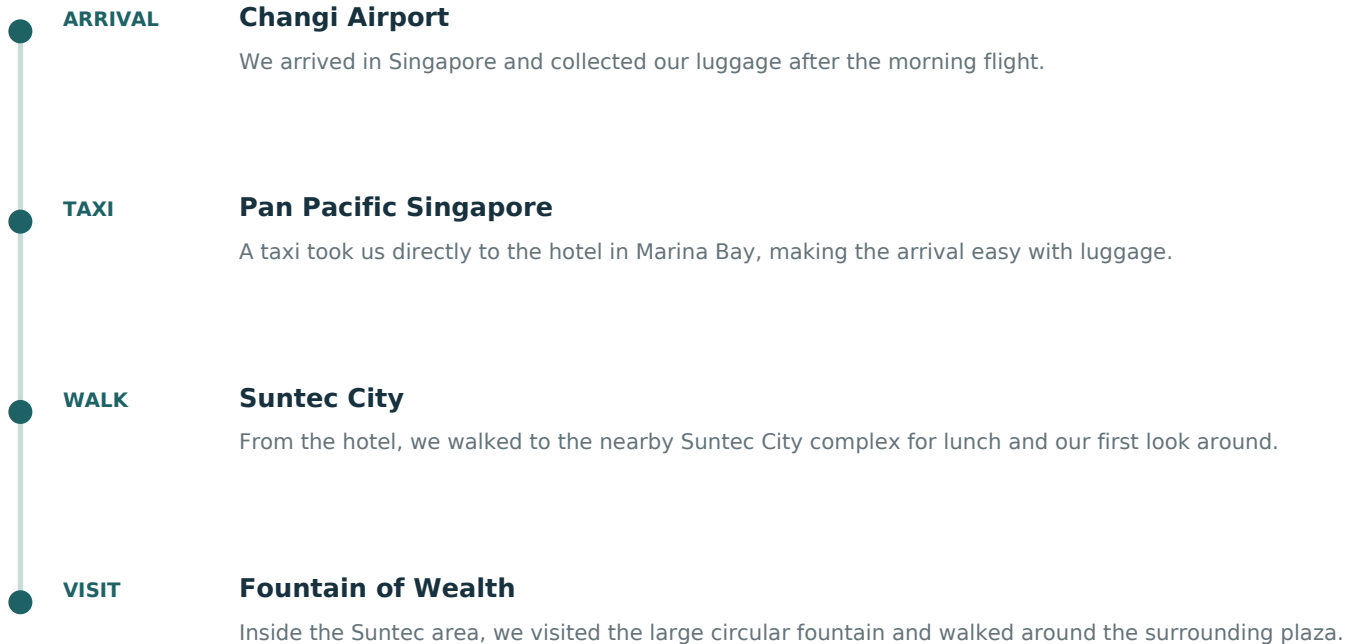


FLIGHT TO SINGAPORE

PAN PACIFIC SINGAPORE

Our base was connected to Marina Bay and Suntec, so many attractions, restaurants and transport links were within an easy walk.

HOW WE GOT AROUND

We mostly walked or used the MRT, tapping a Mastercard directly at the gates. Standard taxis were used only between Changi Airport and the hotel.



Day 1 - Gardens by the Bay

From Suntec, we tapped our Mastercard for the MRT into Singapore's famous waterfront garden district and explored it step by step.



INSIDE THE GARDENS

1 - FLORAL FANTASY

An indoor floral attraction filled with imaginative flower displays. This was our first ticketed stop at Gardens by the Bay.

2 - CLOUD FOREST

A cool, misty conservatory built around a tall indoor mountain, tropical plants and a dramatic waterfall.

3 - DESSERT BREAK

We paused for dessert near the cooled conservatories before continuing through the rest of the Gardens.

4 - FLOWER DOME

The vast glass greenhouse displays flowers and plants from Mediterranean, savannah and desert climates.

THE EVENING OUTSIDE

A walk through the park

After the indoor attractions, we wandered through the outdoor gardens and took in the Supertrees, waterfront paths and Marina Bay skyline.

Dinner at Gardens by the Bay

We stayed in the Gardens area for dinner, then returned to Pan Pacific Singapore to end the first day.

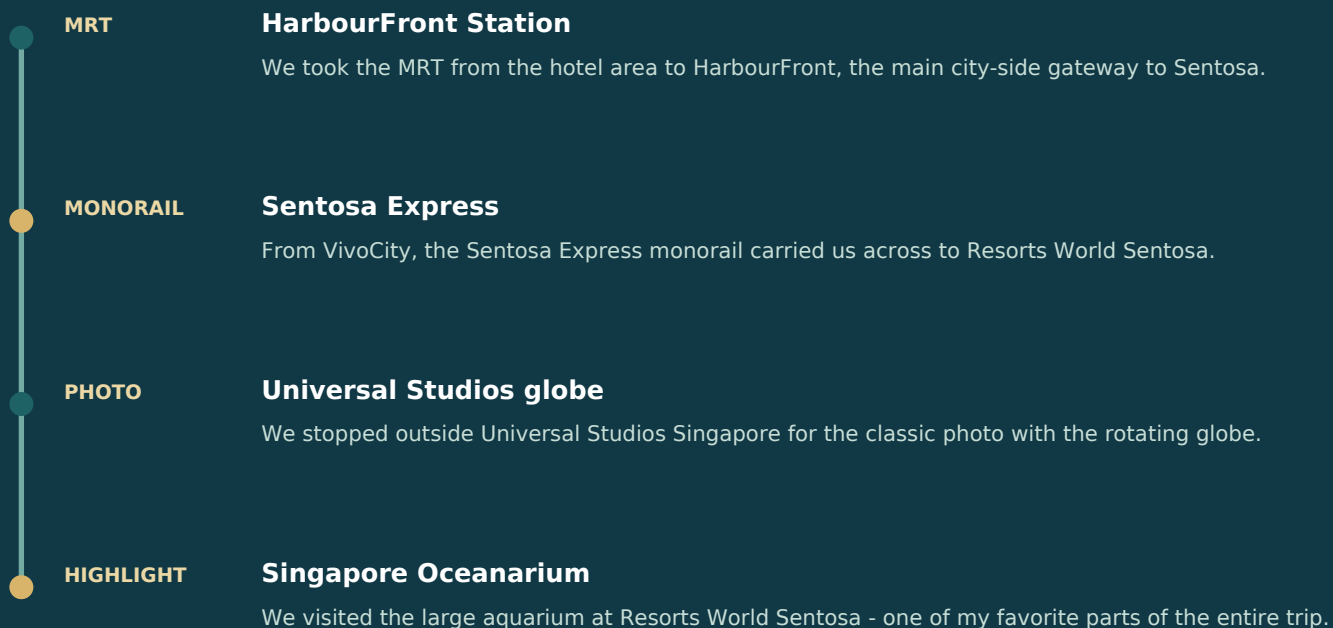

We crossed from the city to Sentosa for a full day of marine life, beaches and cable-car views.



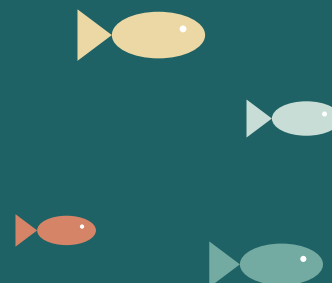
THE ROUTE INTO SENTOSA

The immersive marine displays were calm, enormous and easy to explore slowly. This became the standout attraction of the trip.



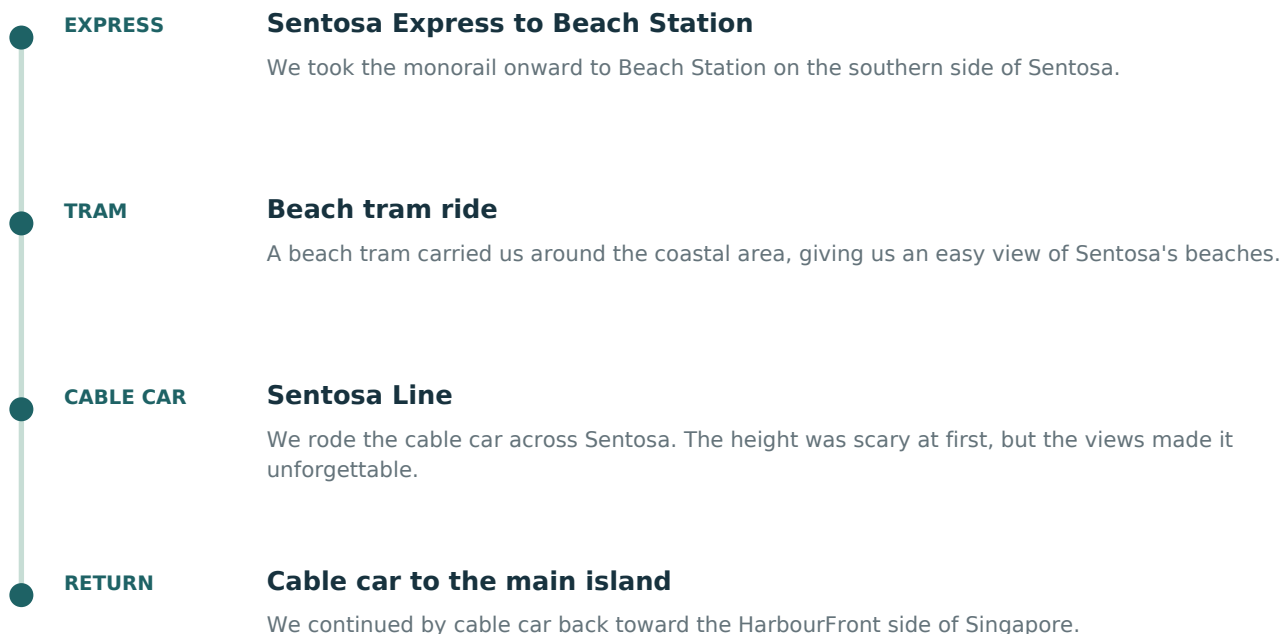
WHY IT STAYED WITH ME

It was not just another stop. The scale, atmosphere and quiet underwater world made it genuinely memorable.

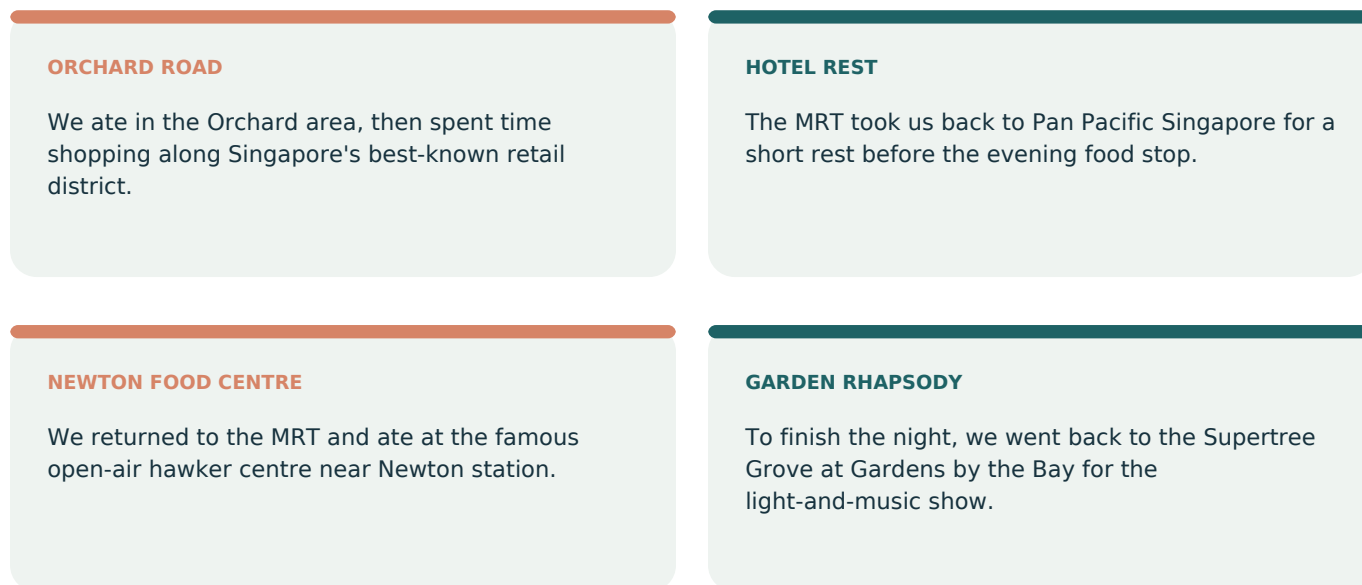
Day 2 - From Sentosa to the city

A FINAL WALK THROUGH CENTRAL SINGAPORE

- WALK** **Pan Pacific to Merlion Park**
We walked from the hotel to the waterfront to see Singapore's famous Merlion statue and Marina Bay view.
- WALK** **Merlion Park to City Hall**
From the Merlion, we continued on foot through the Civic District toward City Hall.
- RETURN** **Back to the hotel**
We walked back to Pan Pacific Singapore, collected our luggage and checked out.
- TAXI** **Straight to Changi Airport**
After checkout, a standard taxi took us directly to the airport with our luggage.
